

Port Orforde Jubilee Parade Rules

Parade participants must comply with all parade rules and instructions given to them by parade officials. Failure to comply with parade rules will result in the entry being immediately removed from the parade. The Port Orford Jubilee retains the right to change these rules at any time as deemed necessary to conform to the intent and theme of the parade, to ensure the safety of everyone, and to ensure the continued integrity and success of the event.

1. This is a **non-political parade** and is not a 'protest' parade or event. Although we do allow representation of/by political party organizations, we do not allow anti-campaigning or protest against any other person, organization, party or entity. Any entries discovered to be demonstrating or lobbying against political issues, protesting a person, party, entity, or established statute/law/constitutional amendment, displaying any other "anti" or negative materials or media will not be allowed to participate in the parade, at the sole discretion of the Port Orford Jubilee. Anyone displaying unacceptable signs, or distributing political advertising, or other materials deemed controversial or provoking by the Port Orford Jubilee, will be removed from the parade or the pre-parade lineup immediately, at the sole discretion of the Port Orford Jubilee. Parade participants may display support materials for sitting elected officials, current constitutional laws/amendments, or political parties, but again – NO "anti", protest, challenging, or otherwise negative materials will be allowed.
2. Entry applications will not be accepted when the Port Orford Jubilee determines an entry to be controversial, unlawful, or inconsistent with the standards, the theme and the purposes of the Port Orford Jubilee parade. At any time after acceptance an entry may not be allowed to participate in the parade if it deviates from the original application, violates any parade rule, or is deemed otherwise unacceptable by the Port Orford Jubilee.
3. All entries should be decorated and theme related when possible.
4. Entries broadcasting music or singing are strongly encouraged, and the Jubilee will make every effort to place them in the parade away from others playing music or having loud entries (fire department, etc.)
5. Reasonable discretion should be used concerning the number of individuals permitted to ride on any entry "safely". Individuals are allowed to walk beside an entry.
6. The Port Orford Jubilee encourages self-propelled floats. All entries should be decorated and theme related. If a float is pulled by a vehicle it should also be decorated to conform to the theme. Drivers must remain with entry vehicle.
7. All entries must clear all overhead obstacles. Maximum float/entry height is 14 feet.

8. The name, organization, or purpose of an entry should be clear and visible on each parade entry.
9. All participants and drivers will conduct themselves and operate their vehicles and parade apparatus in a safe manner at all times.
10. Walking participants should be at least 10 years old or accompanied by an adult.
11. No unauthorized entry will be allowed on the parade route.
12. Parade participants are allowed to distributing items such as candy or samples along the parade route. However for safety reasons we do not want children running out into the street to get candy, so please encourage children to stay off the street and on the curb or sidewalks.
13. As a condition of participation, participants agree that the Port Orford Jubilee does not assume responsibility for any injury or harm and agrees to indemnify the Port Orford Jubilee, its staff, volunteers and agents from any and all claims, liabilities, damages and losses arising, directly or indirectly, out of Participant's involvement in the parade.
